Regulations



Regulations and restrictions must follow the common hierarchy as mentioned in this slide.

Motorsport Organizers

Venue	Develop Sanitation plan that follows UAE Authorities guidelines and submit to EMSO.	Venue capacity must observe current UAE government guidelines.	Signage must be used to signify (2m) social distancing and sanitation areas.	Records of all venue visitors must be kept to assist in contact tracing.
Documentation	Online pre- registration shall be accepted and promoted.	Electronic record keeping shall be implemented in all aspects of event management.	Customer service staff must wear PPE and sanitize after each transaction.	Pre-event Scrutineering declaration forms may be used.
Scrutineering	Scrutineering shall take place outside or in a well ventilated area.	Limit team personal access to scrutineering area. Limit 1 per car.	Scrutineers should preferably work individually.	Scrutineers must wear PPE when inspecting the inside of any vehicle.
Stewards	Preferred use of phone or digital means to communicate with officials/teams.	Preferred all reports be accepted electronically.	A steward can work remotely if they are able to fulfil all their duties.	Stewards may conduct interviews with drivers or teams through digital means.

Note: PPE means personal protective equipment.

Officials	Maintain record of all personal and individual teams working in close proximity.	Sign on/off shall be done while maintaining (2m) social distancing.	Preferred the sign on/off shall be done utilizing the OMS QR code system.	Officials should avoid medical intervention and wait for medical team.
Race Control	Personal may need to be limited to maintain (2m) social distancing.	Hand Sanitizer at the entrance/exit and proper hygiene observed.	Verbal reports may be received and documented electronically.	May consider relocating certain personal outside of race control if their job is unaffected.
Team Personnel	(2m) Social distance where possible.	Wear PPE when working in close proximity of other team personnel.	Should avoid the sharing of tools. Tools should be sanitized after each use.	Team Managers must record all personnel that attend the event.
Pit Garages	Occupied pit garages must have the doors remain open.	Limit access to only essential team personnel and Officials.	Use of mobile barriers and signage to promote limited access.	Sanitation must be kept up at all times inside garages.

Vehicle Intervention	A record shall be kept for all the names of each team that shares a vehicle.	Personal in a vehicle shall not wait inside the vehicle for extended periods.	Intervention teams shall remain with the same team throughout the event.	PPE to be worn before entering the vehicle.
Medical Resources	Safety Plan to include the plan to deal with suspected positive Covid-19 infections.	Develop medical isolation area for suspected Covid-19 patients.	Limit access to medical facility for only medical personal and patients.	All equipment to be sanitized after each use.
Driver Briefing/ Notice Board	Driver briefing to be conducted electronically or outside.	If outside, (2m) social distancing must be observed.	Digital Notice board is preferred.	Electronic contact information shall be distributed before the event for Senior Officials in the SR's.
Podium Ceremony	Podium area shall be sanitized before and after each use.	Maintain (2m) social distancing if possible and competitors cannot shake hands.	Minimize the amount of officials presenting trophies and no shaking hands with anyone.	Trophies should be sanitized before being handed out.

Media	Reduced media personnel should be considered.	Large scale press conferences should be cancelled.	Media interviews should not be given inside pit garages.	Interviews shall be given in designated area that is sterilized and maintained.
Media	Remote interviews through the use of video conferencing tools should be used.	Shared microphones should be sanitized after each use.	Non-essential Media personnel should work remotely if possible.	Media data should only be transferred digitally by soft copy.
Rally	Rally events that require a crew of 2 or more, may have to submit Medical declaration.	Organizers should establish health monitoring system for all crews and teams.	Crews/Teams may have to submit health reports daily throughout the event to CMO.	Event organizer to have procedures for any member of the event to report a change in health.
Rally	Ensure crews receive instructions on sanitation requirements for all personnel/vehicles.	Crew must maintain their personal equipment by themselves only.	Only essential event personnel allowed access inside venue or bivouac.	Food catering to be avoided or minimized if possible.

Competitors	All must have their temperature checked (max 37.5c) before entering venue.	Any rental safety equipment issued to competitors, must be sterilized after use.	No sharing of personal safety equipment is allowed. PSE should be managed only by the competitor.	Driving age restrictions must comply with UAE government regulations.
Competitors	Competitors with chronic disease and serious health conditions may not compete.	Competitors with a risk in their immune system, may not compete.	Competitors who show clear symptoms of respiratory infection or fever. Must isolate themselves and inform the CMO.	Notify all competitors of any other person that has tested positive of Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
Officials / Marshals	All must have their temperature checked (max 37.5c) before entering venue.	Maintain (2m) social distancing where and when possible.	Shall be provided and must wear PPE when coming in contact with others .	Job Posts should be communicated electronically before the event.
Venue Staff	Venue staff shall receive specific training in sanitation protocols.	Maintain (2m) social distancing where and when possible.	Must wear PPE when coming in contact with others or performing sanitation services.	Do not report to work if feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of Covid-19.

PPE	As mandated by the UAE government wearing of face masks is mandatory.	PPE should be used when handling any waste.	Advanced PPE should be used by medical personal.	PPE Should be changed or sanitized often to ensure effectiveness.
Sterilization	Must comply with UAE Government regulations and be documented.	Common contact surfaces should be clean regularly.	All shared equipment must be sterilized after each use.	Maintain a sterilization schedule and ensure it is adhered to.
Hygiene	Basic hygiene should be observed and practiced by all persons.	Extra hand washing stations and sanitizer should be available in all common areas.	No spitting!	Cover your mouth when coughing.
Signage and Barriers	Signage shall be used to mark social distance limits.	Signage should mark hand hygiene stations.	Barriers should be used to control access.	Barriers should be used in front desk where customer interactions take place.

Marshals	Group Size must follow UAE regulations. Social Distancing must be observed.	Shared equipment must be sterilized after each use.	Written tests should be avoided and tests should be given by electronic means if possible.	Webinar based trainings to be utilized when possible.
Driving Instructor	Group Size must follow UAE regulations.	Social Distancing must be observed.	Driving Instructors should not ride in the vehicle with the driver.	Electronic communication preferred between driver and instructor.
Venue Staff	All Staff should receive training on Covid-19.	Staff should receive training on sterilization methods.	Staff should be trained on taking a temperature using a IR Temp Tool.	Management should receive training on contact tracing and consider putting in place a system.
